

Construction of the COVID-19 screening station at the Zero Mile Toll Gate of Yangon-Mandalay Highway

A COVID-19 screening station is under construction at the Zero Mile Toll Gate of Yangon-Mandalay Highway, said U Tin Myint, Chairman of the COVID-19 Treatment and Support Working Committee.

Under the guidance of the Ministry of Health and Sports, and the Yangon Region Government, Shwe Than Lwin Company (SKY NET) and Myanmar Licensed Contractors Association (MLCA) is constructing this COVID-19 Screening Station.

“According to the regional government's directive, the COVID-19 screening station is built to screen all drivers and passengers who are travelling in or out of the city. It is estimated that around 500 vehicles will be screened per day. The station will consist of driver and passenger lounge for temporary rest, doctor and nurse rooms, a blood testing room, bathrooms and toilets, said U Tin Myint.

The Construction work of the Screening Station will be completed tonight and it will be handed over to the Yangon Regional Government tomorrow afternoon, 12th October 2020.
