Inya Centre Opened for Treatment of Covid-19 Patients

Inya Covid-19 Treatment Centre began operation on 10th October 2020 evening following the handover ceremony from the donors to the authority. The donors which contributed K1000 million by KBZ Bank, K300 million by Shwe Than Lwin (Sky Net), K100 million by Myanmar Licensed Contractors Association as the initial fund and K80 million worth of medical use furniture by the Pico Myanmar Company respectively, have fully converted the Yangon Convention Centre to an over 500-bed hospital within 10 days.

The Centre was handed over to the Yangon Region Government and the Ministry of Health and Sports by the officials of the companies through the Yangon Region Chief Minister U Phyo Min Thein. The Chief Minister said that *“This Inya Centre will be recorded as a landmark of the history.”*

In the evening, the hospital was opened to COVID-19 positive patients and currently over 400 patients are being treated. Inya Center receives and treats all transferred patients in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Sports, said U Thiha Si Thu, Joint Person in Charge of Volunteer Control of the Centre.

The Inya Center will give treatments to the patients with the facilities that include 104 beds equipped with Oxygen Therapy System and 412 regular beds. The Centre also provides three meals a day to patients free and has arranged a food court for doctors and health workers as well.

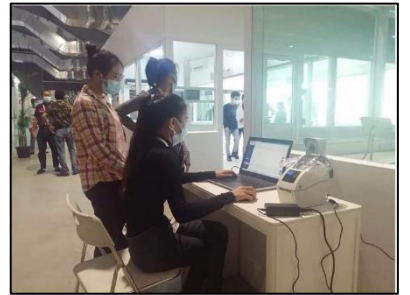
